AGENDA: The Supervisor circulated a copy of the agenda to each Board Member for their review. He called for any additions, deletions or corrections. Hearing none a motion was made by Gibbs and seconded by Marshall to approve the agenda as presented.

OFFICER'S REPORTS: The Supervisor reported that the roof on the chapel is in need of repair, this matter will be looked at in the next budget year. The supervisor also commented that the lines will be painted on the new blacktop as

soon as the contractor has time. Michigan Forest Association has been deeded 40 acres of forest in section six. This piece of land is land locked and they are attempting to get access through adjoining properties. The Supervisor also spoke about the medical marijuana opt in/ opt out ordinance that is being prepared by MTA. The Treasurer said that the tax bills will be out by the end of this month. If bills are not received by the middle of December 2017 to please contact the Treasurer. The Clerk reported that he attended the planning commission meeting on October 12th,2017.
