AGENDA: The supervisor circulated a copy of the agenda to each Board Member for their review. A motion was made by McConnell and seconded by Marshall to approve the agenda as presented.

B. March Board of Review, The Supervisor stated that the March board of review was not busy. There were five requests made and 9 veteran exemptions requested by mail.

A. Chart of accounts. The Clerk spoke on the requirement by the State to follow a uniform chart of accounts for the accounting program. More discussions will be held on this in the following months.

Silker commented that the wind turbines were not spinning. Lasher stated that there will be an increase in tax revenues due to the turbines.
