

A regular monthly meeting of the Gilmore Township Board was held on May 10th, 2023 at the Gilmore Township Hall.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: A motion was made by McConnell and seconded by Silker to approve the agenda. All Yeas being heard the motion carried. Yeas-5, Nays-0

NEW BUSINESS: A. Woods of Gilmore. A discussion was held on renaming an area of the township. A motion was made by Gibbs and seconded by McConnell to reject the renaming of the area. A roll call vote was taken. McConnell-Yeas, Silker-Yeas, Marshall-Yeas, Gibbs-Yeas, Lasher-Yeas.

B. Isabella County Hazardous mitigation plan. A discussion was held on adopting a resolution to participate in the plan. A decision will be made at the June 2023 meeting.

OFFICER'S REPORT: Marshall stated that taxes for the previous year need to be paid to the county now. Gibbs stated the need for a new

Clerk and reported on the upcoming elections in the year 2023. Lasher stated that the new cemetery software has been ordered and that learning how to install information into the system will begin within the next month. Silker gave an update on the history of Gilmore Township.
