

A regular monthly meeting of the Gilmore Township Board was held on Wednesday, September 9th, 2020 at the Gilmore Township Hall.

AGENDA: The supervisor circulated a copy of the agenda to each Board Member for their review. A motion was made by Gibbs and seconded by Silker to approve the agenda as presented.

All Yeas being heard the motion carries: Yeas-5, Nays-0

PREVIOUS MINUTES: The Clerk circulated a copy of the August 12th, 2020 meeting minutes to each Board Member for their review. The Supervisor asked for any corrections. A motion was made by McConnell and seconded by Marshall to approve the previous minutes as presented.

TREASURER'S REPORT: The Treasurer circulated a copy of the Treasurer's report to each Board Member and read it aloud. A motion was made by McConnell and seconded by Gibbs to approve the Treasurer's report in the amount of \$12,979.85 with check numbers 8688-8700.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: A. Sign for township hall. A discussion was held on placing a sign on the township hall stating the year ~~the hall was placed into service~~ *the township was founded*. A motion was made by Gibbs and seconded by McConnell to approve the purchase of the sign in the amount of \$65.00 from All State Sign Company in Farwell. All Yeas being heard the motion carries: Yeas-5, Nays-0.

B. Cemetery well update. Gibbs stated that Dan Moore repaired the well in the east side cemetery at no charge to the township. Gibbs stated that Dan also recommended removing the pump head before winter arrives. Thank you to Dan Moore for his help with this matter.

C. 2020 census. The township is ranking the lowest in the county for reporting for the 2020 census. Census workers will be at Pohl's Party Store on the 16th and 22nd of September.

D. Drain assessments. The Supervisor attended the meeting with the drain commission and reported that the township will be responsible for \$8357.60 in assessments. There is no appeal process for this matter.

E. The supervisor has been in contact with Roger Hauck and the DNR on setting some limitations on Littlefield lake. Roger Hauck will have further discussions with the DNR on setting up a meeting for residents and all others who would like to attend. The meeting will not be in the near future due to Covid-19.

OFFICER'S REPORTS: Gibbs spoke on the upcoming election in November. Marshall stated that she is not going to complete separate fire and garbage reports due to the fact that they are already included in the treasurer's report. Marshall also stated that taxpayers will pay interest on their taxes if they are not paid for by the 14th of September, 2020. McConnell stated that there is a tire collection at the fair grounds on the 12th of September from 8 until noon.
